

PerKelt is a Pagan Speed Folk band based in London, UK. Their poetry and strong message of freedom and joy merges together with crazily fast, powerful rhythms and joyful melodies. The music of PerKelt blends together the upbeat "engine" of drums and guitars, their trademark unrivalled duels of fiddle and recorders, haunting pagan vocals and the deep tribal vibes of didgeridoo.



Yarrr! **The Captain's Beard** be a company o' travelin' troubadors on a quest te bring the finest o' sea shantys and forebitters to the ears of all who'll listen. We play songs of the grog, grot and grime that comes o' travelling the high seas. Fer all who enjoy the pirates life let us be yer soundtrack!



The Fabulous Red Diesel is an original jazzy 4 piece have sold out Ronnie Scott's Upstairs 3 times in the last 2 years. Their latest album 'Goddess The Seahorse' made it onto Jazz FM, and was featured as track of the week on Dinner Jazz. Buckle up for the ride of your lives, and watch out for that tuba!



Victor & The Bully Armed with a steampunk aesthetic and bringing in a thunderous twisted sound of Guitars, pianos, violins, trumpets and anything we can throw in the mix, they create a carnival blend of music inspired by pop, punk, swing, mariachi, classical and metal to blow the cobwebs away and get the feet tapping!



Kaya Ruppo is a multidisciplinary creator and artist. Through her connection to the world of nature, folklore, and pagan realms, she brings expression to the stage and to people. Additionally, she creates land art, tells stories, and conducts empowerment workshops for women of all ages inspired by goddesses and mythical female figures.



Ravenhymn is a 3 piece neo-medieval project hailing from London and Kent. Blending bagpipes, vocals and drums with the somewhat more modern bass guitar, Ravenhymn sets out to bring the raucous times of Middle Ages debauchery to the modern world.



The 286 A seven piece band from London, The 286 dare to cross the genres of indie rock and classical music. By clashing rock & roll riffs with cellos and violins, The 286 create a unique sound that you expect from a musical collaboration between The Beatles and Beethoven.



Nova Halo is the synergistic pseudonym title of alt pop songstress Nancy's works. Not quite an alter ego and not quite a band, but the liminal project title of a revolving line up steered by a fixed frontwoman. Her seraphic vocals fluctuating from bright and gossamer to dark and raspy repose, fantasian aesthetics and beguiling songs have been intriguing audiences since 2017.



Experimental Sonic Machines is an electronic & acoustic music project from Lincoln, accompanied by robot drummer Ernie. All the music is original & most of the instruments are made from scrap materials. At previous Faerie Festivals the organfishes have appeared & at this year's festival the 2 metre organfish might be appearing...



Named after the hometown of Elizabeth I's court magician, Dr John Dee, **Mortlake** is an eldritch blend of 70's era folk revival, folk horror and a healthy dose of Tudor and Medieval influences. Our songs are written for the most part based on local legends and tales from the windswept Romney Marsh, where we are based.



Fae As Folk Bards from beyond the veil bring you fantasy folk and spooky stories. Come with us on a journey through the Unseelie Courts and wander through the crumbling halls of our ancestors days. Suspend your disbelief and escape from this late-stage capitalist dystopia. To a land where the Fae still rule.



Touch The Earth are a pagan tribal folk band who make music to touch the heart. Their inspiration flows from the Celtic heritage of this land. The group also has a shamanic centre on the Isle of Sheppey where they frequently hold ceremonies and celebrations.



Willows Drum A dynamic duo of guitars, mandolin and drums along with songs that hail from nature, spirit and tradition. This folk based pair of individuals who will take you to the realms of the fae, to the mountains, hills and fields of magical Albion and beyond.



Car Dia Susan Marie Paramor is a weaver of songs of the land from an early age, singing and creating poetry in song. Aged eleven, she was Head of the Dhekelia Cathedral Choir in Cyprus after which she went on to sing opera, jazz, musical theatre and folk. Lead singer in jazz band 'Get Wise' while, at the same time, taking on roles in theatre, film and on television.



Modnessa - translating to 'Unity' in Old English - our tribal-trance-folk takes the listener on an etheric & atmospheric journey across ancient landsvibes of didgeridoo.



Cyoakha Grace is a haunting world and trance 4 octave vocalist, songwriter-film composer, and live trance dance looper whose magical songs have been called "a wild carpet ride" and whose music has been commissioned for film and won composer awards. She's been a festival gipsy for years, performing at the Oregon Country Fair, Burning Man, and many more.



The first incarnation of **Pentacle Drummers** were formed on 28th July 2001 for the Eastbourne Giants (Herne and Andred), to beat a path for them at the very first Eastbourne Lammas Festival. However the group was just known as the Eastbourne Giants and Drummers for a couple of years.



Lyz Le Fay is a singer and songwriter who plays a variety of instruments. Her ethereal voice will transport you to the magical realms and enchant you with folkloric tales and songs. She will mesmerise you with her handwritten and re-woven traditional works.



Alternative Folkie Shell Turnbull is an artist who draws on her love of the earth, life, death, and beyond for inspiration. With just a guitar and a drum, she writes songs with passionate pagan themes. Using dark gothic visuals while singing softly and belting out her vocals in equal measure to captivate her audience.
